Issue/Topic:	Timber Sale Revenue Appropriation
Proposed Change:	The Department requests a new "all moneys received" appropriation in Program 1 to contract with cooperating foresters to assist with the establishment of timber sales on state lands to implement a provision included in 2005 Wisconsin Act 166 that created s. 28.05 (3), Stats.
Explanatory Note: <i>Robin</i>	The provision created in s.28.05(3), Stats. Directs the Department to establish, by rule, a program that authorizes the Department to contract with cooperating foresters for the purpose of harvesting and selling timber from state forest lands and authorizes cooperating foresters to receive a portion of the proceeds from each timber sale. Under current law, all proceeds from timber sales on Department lands are deposited to the Conservation Fund. To implement the new provision, the Department requests a new appropriation for "Contracting for Timber Sale Establishment" to be funded with timber sale proceeds from the Conservation Fund on an as-needed basis through allotment requests to the Department of Administration. It is intended that the appropriation be an administratively split-funded appropriation, with proportionate splits coming from the administrative accounts where the timber sale revenue is credited. An "all moneys received" appropriation is requested because it is not known how much spending authority will be needed year to year.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to establish a program that allows private cooperating foresters to assist the state in the harvesting and sale of timber from state forest lands to meet annual timber harvest requirements. Under current law, those cooperating foresters are entitled to receive payment for their services in an amount equal to a portion of the proceeds of each timber sale. Under this bill, an amount equal to that portion of those timber sale proceeds are credited to a specific appropriation to be used to make payments to those cooperating foresters.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 20.370 (1) (cy) of the statutes is created to read:
4 20.370 (1) (cy) Forestry - cooperating foresters. All moneys received under s.
5 28.05 (3) (a) for the payment to cooperating foresters to be used for those payments.

1 **SECTION 2.** 28.05 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

2 28.05 (3) (a) The department shall, by rule, establish a program that allows
3 private cooperating foresters to assist the state in the harvesting and sale of timber
4 from state forest lands to meet the annual allowable timber harvest established
5 under s. 28.025. The rule shall include provisions authorizing the department to
6 contract with cooperating foresters for the purpose of harvesting and selling timber
7 from state forest lands and authorizing cooperating foresters to receive a portion of
8 the proceeds from each timber sale. The department shall establish in the rule a
9 method for determining what portion of the proceeds received from each timber sale
10 shall be paid to the private cooperating foresters for their services in assisting the
11 division in the harvesting and sale of timber from state forest lands. The division
12 shall ask the council on forestry to recommend a method for determining what
13 portion of the proceeds received from each timber sale shall be paid to private
14 cooperating foresters under the rule. Of the amounts received from timber sales
15 under this subsection, the department shall credit to the appropriation under s.
16 20.370 (1) (cy) the amounts equal to the portion of the proceeds from those sales that
17 the department is required to pay to cooperating foresters under this subsection.

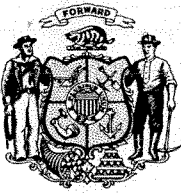

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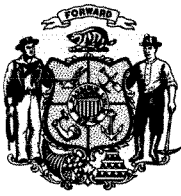
