Tuition Fee Remission Program Changes

Under the current tuition fee remission program (also known as the Wisconsin G.I. bill), an otherwise eligible dependent child of an eligible veteran must be between the ages of 18 and 26 and attending school as a full-time student. The Department proposes that current statutes be amended to reduce the minimum age from 18 to 17 and to eliminate the full-time student status requirement.

Statutory Provisions to be Amended : ss. 36.27 (3n) (b) 3. and 38.24 ~~(8)~~ (b) 3.

Currently, under certain circumstances the University of Wisconsin and each technical college must provide a full remission of fees for 128 credits or eight semesters, whichever is longer, to the spouse, unremarried surviving spouse, or child of an eligible veteran. An eligible veteran is one who died on active duty, died as the result of a service-connected disability, died in the line of duty, or has been awarded at least a 30 percent service-connected disability rating.

Currently, in order to be eligible for the fee remission, the child of the eligible veteran must be at least 18 but not yet 26 years old and a full-time student. This bill reduces the minimum age to 17 and eliminates the full-time requirement.

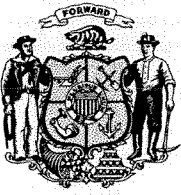
