The request intends to update the nonstatutory language relating to prosecution of drug crimes in Milwaukee, Dane and St. Croix Counties.

The agency suggested the following modification:

(1c) Prosecution of drug crimes; Milwaukee County. From the appropriation account under section 20.505(6)(p) of the statutes the department of administration shall expend \$57,126 and from the appropriation account under section 20.455(2)(kp) of the statutes, the department of justice shall expend \$38,500 in each year of the 2007-09 fiscal biennium to provide the multijurisdictional enforcement group serving Milwaukee County funding for 2.0 district attorney PR positions to prosecute criminal violations of chapter 961 of the statutes.

(1d) Prosecution of drug crimes; Dane County. From the appropriation account under section 20.505(6)(p) of the statutes the department of administration shall expend \$18,568 and from the appropriation account under section 20.455(2)(kp) of the statutes, the department of justice shall expend \$11,875 in each year of the 2007-09 fiscal biennium to provide the multijurisdictional enforcement group serving Dane County funding for 0.75 district attorney PR position to prosecute criminal violations of chapter 961 of the statutes.

(1e) Prosecution of drug crimes; St. Croix County. From the appropriation account under section 20.455(2)(kp) of the statutes, the department of justice shall expend \$68,875 in fiscal year 2007-08 and \$68,875 in fiscal year 2008-09 to provide the multijurisdictional enforcement group serving St. Croix County funding for 1.0 district attorney PR position to prosecute criminal violations of chapter 961 of the statutes.

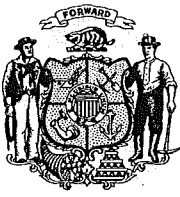
