The Department requests \$5,000,000 in general obligation bonding to fund investigations and remedial actions at contamination sites throughout the state. This includes the state's share of federal Superfund projects as well as projects for which the state takes the lead on cleanup. In addition to federal Superfund sites, potential cleanup sites include landfills, dry cleaning facilities, industrial and petroleum sites where there is no viable responsible party, and environmental emergencies. The Department also has the opportunity to participate in partnership projects where state funds leverage significant voluntary or municipal funding for remediation and redevelopment efforts. Approximately \$2.3 million in bonding authority remains at the end of the current biennium. When combined with the request for \$5 million in increased authority, the state would be able to undertake \$7.3 million in projects, roughly 19% of a conservative estimate of potential projects.

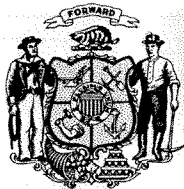
