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

We've recently limited the scope of the child care quality ratings system. Instead of all licensed, certified and contracted providers, the Department of Health and Family services day care licensing staff will rate licensed centers on a voluntary basis. All centers receiving subsidies from the state under 49.175(1)(p) will be required to participate, however.

I don't believe that we intend on implementing the tiered reimbursement system in the current biennium, but I would leave the language authorizing DWD to do so in nonetheless.

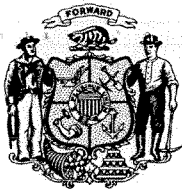
Last one Pam.

1. Recent discussions have led us to decide that the only licensed providers who receive subsidies from the state under s. 49.155(3m) would be rated. Other providers licensed under s. 48.65 but who do not receive state subsidies under s. 49.155(3m) could be rated upon request. Certified providers would not be included in the ratings system.
2. We've decided not to do a tiered reimbursement system this time around, so 49.155(6)(e) can be stricken from the draft.
3. The ratings will be done by licensing staff working on day care licensing under s. 48.65. Does this need to be mentioned in statute?
4. The idea was to have initial ratings of all licensed providers receiving state subsidies by the end of the biennium. Is this something we need to spell out in statute or can this be done by administrative rule?

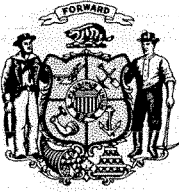

Under current law, DHFS may license a person to operate a day care center, a county department of human services or social services (county department) may certify a day care provider for reimbursement under the Wisconsin Works (W-2) program, and a school board may establish or contract for the provision of day care programs for children. This bill requires DWD to provide a child care quality rating system that rates the quality of the child care provided by a child care provider licensed by DHFS that receives reimbursement under the W-2 program for the child care provided or that volunteers for rating under the system. DWD must make the rating information provided under the system available to parents, guardians, and legal custodians of children who are recipients, or prospective recipients, of care and supervision from a child care provider that is rated under the system, including making that information available on DWD's Internet site.
