Grants for science, technology, engineering and mathematics programming

- Establish a new appropriation for a categorical aid under s. 20.255 (2)(fz) [suggested by DPI], with the title "Grants for science, technology, engineering and math programming". This would be a GPR, annual appropriation.
- Create a new section under chapter 115 to establish the new grant program
- Under this new program, schools districts could receive grants for the following purposes:
 - developing innovative instructional programming in the subjects of science, technology, engineering and math;
 - targeting students who are typically under-represented in these subjects;
 - increasing academic and technical achievement in these subjects
- Grants would be awarded by DPI on a competitive basis
- Grants would first be available for the 2007-08 school year
- Require DPI to promulgate rules to administer this section.

Brief Description of Intent:

Create a Chapter 20 appropriation line for a new initiative entitled Grants for science, technology, engineering, mathematics programming.

The department is requesting this statutory change because the proposed program, which has the acronym STEM, would annually distribute \$61,500 GPR in mini-grants to create systems and processes for identifying and supporting under-represented and academically challenged students in STEM earlier than in the past. This will be implemented by providing mini-grants to school districts on a competitive basis. The money is to be used to provide schools with seed money to develop innovative STEM instructional programming, targeting students under-represented in STEM, and increase academic and technical achievement.
