

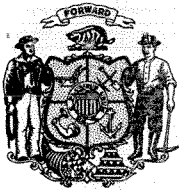

Proposed language: "The Department of Workforce Development shall complete a study concerning the efficiency of Wisconsin's methodology for collecting child support payments and by December 1, 2008 submit the Department's findings and recommendations to the Secretary of Administration."

Notes:

- This study is being proposed to look at the efficiency of current court centered process of collecting funds. It is also meant to look at the possibility of creating a more "debt-collection" focused model for child support collections that could be housed in the Department of Revenue.
 - Not sure how much specificity is appropriate for language like this. If you have any input it would be appreciated.
- Not sure of the timeline necessary for such a study to take place. The example I saw in Act 25 set a December 1 due date. Is there a more standard period of time to use?
