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

Current Language

Current language at s. 301.26(7) and s. 301.26(8) specify the amount of youth aids funding the Department of Corrections shall allocate to counties for the biennium.

Proposed Change

Update the statutes for youth aids to reflect the dates of the 2007-09 biennial budget.

Provide an additional allocation of \$5 million in each year under s. 301.26(7) based on each county proportion of juveniles placed in a juvenile correctional facility during the most recent 3 year period for which that information is available.

Desired effective date: Upon passage of the bill
