Maybe the way to think of it is that under this program, a district would get one two-year grant: in the first year the grant would be equal to the number of 4K pupils x \$3000 and in the second year, the grant would be equal to the number of 4K pupils x \$1500. Perhaps instead of saying "two annual grants" it should really say "one two-year grant"? The intent is to provide districts with the resources (ability to spend) for a new 4K program in the first two years (districts would not be able to count all the 4K pupils for revenue limit purposes until the 3rd year); thus, we want a district to get the grant in years 1 and 2 (these are categorical aid grants, and thus can be spent outside the revenue limit). Does that make more sense to you?

Bob, would you agree with this approach (I've attached the draft from the 2005-07 budget for your reference).

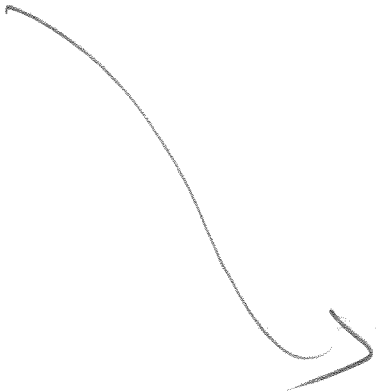

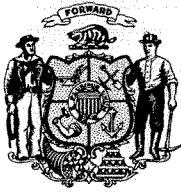
