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

Can we do something like the following nonstat language from Act 25?

9109 (5f) FUNDING FOR CERTAIN COMMUNITY REINTEGRATION SERVICES. From the appropriation under section 20.410 (1) (d), the department of corrections shall provide \$50,000 during the 2006-07 fiscal year to Word of Hope Ministries, Inc., for community reintegration services.

It would be funding for transitional jobs services provided by New Hope Project, Inc.  
It would be out of 20.410(1)(d).  
DOC would provide \$500,000 in each year of the biennium for transitional jobs services

This bill requires DOC to provide funding for Project New Hope, Inc., a transitional employment program for criminal offenders.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.410 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:
20.410 (1) (d) Purchased services for offenders. The amounts in the schedule for the purchase of goods, care and services, including community-based residential care, authorized under s. 301.08 (1) (b) 1., and the halfway house program under s. 301.0465, for inmates, probationers, parolees and persons on extended supervision. In addition, funds from this appropriation shall be used to reimburse programs

2 Wisconsin Act . . . . (this act), section 9109 (1).
