Currently, the Office of Justice Assistance (OJA) provides grants to cities to employ uniformed police officers whose primary duty is beat patrolling. This bill authorizes OJA to provide additional grants to first class cities to employ uniformed police officers whose duties may or may not include beat patrolling.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 16.964 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:
