PUBLIC UTILITY REGULATION

Under current law, a program administered by the PSC for making grants for upgrading wireless emergency "911" telephone systems is no longer in effect approximately three and a half years after the effective date of certain rules promulgated by the PSC. ✓ Because the rules had an effective date of October 1, 2005, the program is no longer in effect after April 1, 2009. ✓ This bill amends the appropriation for the grant program to clarify that no moneys may encumbered or expended from the appropriation after April 1, 2009. ✓ *be*

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 20.155 (3) (q) of the statutes is amended to read:
3 20.155 (3) (q) *General program operations and grants.* From the wireless 911
4 fund, all moneys received under s. 146.70 (3m) (f) 1. to administer and make grants

1 under s. 146.70 (3m) (d) and supplemental grants under s. 146.70 (3m) (e). No
2 moneys may be encumbered or expended from this appropriation after April 1, 2009. ✓

Nikki Hatch:

Under my reading of the PSC's rules, the rules establishing the surcharge were effective October 1, 2005. ✓ Other rules regarding the grant program had an earlier effective date of January 1, 2005. ✓ The sunset date is dependent on the effective date of the surcharge rules, and I calculated the sunset date to be April 1, 2009. You may want the PSC to confirm the foregoing. ✓

Also, an alternative to the approach taken in this draft would be to repeal the appropriation, as well as s. 146.70 (3m), effective April 1, 2009. ✓ Let me know if you prefer that alternative. (I don't think that you can repeal the appropriation without repealing s. 146.70 (3m).) ✓
