

I'd like to amend the legislative request I sent you yesterday. What I sent you yesterday included the following language

We would actually like to break this appropriation in two, so it would look more like the following two PR-S appropriations.

- 20.445(3)(kb) *Boys and Girls Clubs* All moneys received from s. 20.435(1)(gm) to support Boys and Girls Clubs in first class cities.
