## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law authorizes the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to produce periodicals and other publications. The law authorizes DNR to refuse to reveal names and addresses of persons who subscribe to its periodicals and other publications. This bill authorizes DNR to also refuse to reveal the electronic mail addresses of persons who subscribe to its periodicals and other publications.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Section 1.** 23.16 (3) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

The department may charge a fee to recover the actual costs for providing or for the use of a publication subscriber list. No person who obtains or uses a publication subscriber list from the department may refer to the department or the publication as the source of names or, addresses, or electronic mail addresses unless the person clearly states that the provision of, or permission to use, the subscriber list in no way indicates any of the following:
