

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law authorizes the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to produce periodicals and other publications. The law authorizes DNR to refuse to reveal names and addresses of persons who subscribe to its periodicals and other publications. This bill authorizes DNR to also refuse to reveal the electronic mail addresses of persons who subscribe to its periodicals and other publications.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 23.16 (3) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
5 **23.16 (3) SUBSCRIBER LISTS.** (intro.) The department may refuse to reveal
