In response to repeated requests from our hunting and fishing public, the DNR Bureau of Customer Service has developed a tool to allow our customers to sign up to receive automated e-mail from the Department. This automated e-mail distribution service (list-serve) delivers up-to-date information on hunting/fishing law changes, season dates, application deadline dates, outdoor calendars, etc., several times throughout the year.

Many of our customers have requested that we not disclose their e-mail addresses to the public due to the potential damage that can be inflicted on a customer's computer through delivery of unsolicited e-mail. In an attempt to accommodate our customer's requests, we would like to make our Hunting and Fishing Updates a publication. We will assign it a publication number and post it on the internet as well as provide a copy to the required libraries. We could then e-mail our subscribers a link to the most recent publication on the internet.

If the following modifications were made to Chapter 23, we would have the ability to protect all of our customer's e-mail addresses who subscribe to this service. Thank you for your consideration.



1 **AN ACT ...; relating to:** refusal by the department of natural resources to reveal
2 electronic mail addresses of subscribers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law authorizes the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to produce periodicals and other publications. The law authorizes DNR to refuse to reveal names and addresses of persons who subscribe to its periodicals ^{and} other publications. This bill ~~also~~ ^{also} authorizes DNR to refuse to reveal the electronic mail addresses of persons who subscribe to its periodicals and other publications.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 23.16 (3) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 23.16 (3) **SUBSCRIBER LISTS.** (intro.) The department may refuse to reveal
5 names and, addresses, and electronic mail addresses of persons on any magazine or
6 periodical subscriber list. The department may charge a fee to recover the actual
7 costs for providing or for the use of any magazine or periodical subscriber list. The
8 department may not reveal names and addresses of persons as prohibited under s.
