

This bill designates the first full week of November in which November 11 falls as "Veteran Awareness Week," to honor the contributions and sacrifices of veterans. To receive the certificate, the veteran must complete 20 hours of service in a classroom that involves direct contact with students, emphasizing the lessons the veteran learned from his or her military experience.

X The bill requires the department of veterans affairs to award a certificate of achievement and appreciation to veterans who voluntarily serve in private or public schools. To receive the certificate, the veteran must complete 20 hours of service in a classroom that involves direct contact with students, emphasizing the lessons the veteran learned from his or her military experience.
