Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

There are 4,782 Dentists that are currently licensed by the Department of Regulation and Licensing. Dentists must renew their license every two years.

Dentists would report their continuing education on their renewal form. DRL staff would audit for signatures certifying compliance with requirements. Incomplete applications would require follow-up correspondence.

To further encourage compliance with continuing education requirements, audits of 10% of renewal applications are performed. Licensees unable to provide proof of compliance would require follow-up, and potentially, referral to the Division of Enforcement for investigation and possible disciplinary action.

The fiscal impact is detailed below.

Annualized costs (biennial costs were calculated below) = \$31,600

Review renewal applications for compliance with continuing education certification and correspond with applicants missing the requirement:

135 Office Operations Associate hours @ \$20 per hour = \$2,700

Answer questions regarding CE requirements: 116 Operations Program Associate hours @ \$24 per hour = \$2,800

Audit 10% of applicants for compliance:

1,200 Licensing Examinations Spec-Senior hours @ \$33 per hour = \$39,600

Screen, investigate, hear and settle 25 complaints in the renewal year for non-compliance: 208 Attorney hours @ \$57 per hour = \$11,900 208 Investigator hours @ \$30 per hour = \$6,200

All hourly rates include fringe calculated at 42.09%.
