Hi Brett,

I think I contacted you a couple weeks ago regarding a redraft of 2005 AB 431 with a bit of an adjustment. The bill is regarding special license plates for first responders. What we're trying to do is incorporate first responders into the group of people eligible for specialized plates but without the \$10,200 one-time cost for data processing system programming found in the fiscal note. I previously spoke with Carson Frazier who said the reason for this cost was the labor required to create a new group. Essentially, I was thinking maybe you could draft it to add first responders to the EMT designation under 341.14(6r)(f)48 so it would say "Emergency Medical Technicians and EMTs. The idea being, it wouldn't increase costs for the DOT because it would not add a new subgroup that would have to be placed into the current system. Now I'm not sure if that's the way to do it, but it was just a thought.

I don't remember receiving anything from you on this lately so I was just wondering if you had come up with anything. Let me know if you need any more info from me or if any of this is unclear.

Pursuant to your instructions I have not redrafted 2005 AB-431 (LRB 05-2748) but have instead changed the language in the existing s. 341.14 (6r) (f) 48. that provides for a special distinguishing registration plate group for emergency medical technicians. Pursuant to your instructions I have not redrafted 2005 AB-431 (2005 LRB-2748) but have instead changed the language in the existing s. 341.14 (6r) (f) 48. that provides for a special distinguishing registration plate group for emergency medical technicians.
