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

Pocan Amendments for AB207

1 – A substitute amendment that will:

- a) allow ATT entry into the market, negotiating with local communities
- b) includes any necessary statutory language to allow this, as necessary in current bill
- c) does not roll back peg access or consumer protections

2 – An amendment to AA1 that reduces the hours of service outage to 4 hours of service outage (amendment will restore current law).

3 – An amendment to AA1 that restores the authority of municipalities to adopt ordinances that supplement the statutory standards (amendment will restore current law).

4 – An amendment to ASA1 that deletes all requirements of what a PEG channel must broadcast (amendment will restore current law).

Rep. Pocan:

Under current law, a "cable operator" is defined, in part, ^{as} a person that provides one-way transmission of video programming. This amendment revises the definition to include both the one-way and two-way transmission of video programming. Therefore, the definition will include entities such as AT&T, who have argued that they provide two-way, and not one-way, transmission, and such entities will be subject to the regulation by municipalities.
