Please review this bill carefully to ensure that it is not too broad in scope. As drafted, a member of the military who is no longer a resident will be treated as a resident for all hunting and fishing approvals. This includes approvals subject the preference systems. I did not require members of the military to be on furlough or leave for purposes of being treated as a resident in applying for approvals because I assume they would be able to apply online. However, requirements to show proof of eligiblity may result in applications being made only in person. Please let me know if you want any changes.

I created a delayed effective date to give DNR time to implement the provisions created in this bill. OK?
