, Under current law, confidential communications between a patient and a physician, a registered nurse, a chiroprator, a psychologist, a social worker, a marriage and family therapist, or professional counselor are privileged and may not be disclosed to any other person without the patient's permission. There are a number of exceptions to this privilege, including situations where the examination of a abused or neglected child creates a reasonable ground for the opinion by the physician, registered nurse, chiroprator, psychologist, social worker, marriage and a family therapist, or professional counselor that the abuse or neglect was not accidental.
