Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1	SECTION 1. 94.10 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
2	94.10 (1) (a) "Christmas tree grower" means a person who grows evergreen
3	trees <u>in this state</u> for eventual harvest <u>cutting</u> and sale as Christmas trees , except
4	that "Christmas tree grower" does not include a person who grows evergreen trees
5	for eventual harvest and sale as Christmas trees if the person also grows nursery
6	stock for sale and if the person is licensed under sub. (3).

(a). Payment of the surcharge does not relieve the applicant of any other penalty or liability that may result from the violation, but does not constitute evidence of a violation of par. (a).
