I have drafted this differently than what is currently found for Class A bear licenses in s. 29.184 (6) (b) and (c). Under those provisions, one can apply for a preference point or a license. However, if one applies for a license and is selected, current law is silent on what happens if one does not elect to receive the license. Under this bill, I have included a provision stating that even if one applies for the permit (instead of for a preference point) and is selected, one may decline the permit and receive a preference point instead. Please review carefully and let me know if you want any changes.

I have included a delayed effective date to allow DNR administratively to implement the changes required by this bill. I tried to time the effective date to when applications are currently required for these types of permits.
