Jeff-

I believe that this idea falls within your issue area, but if it doesn't let me know and I will direct it to the correct staff attorney.

Basically Sen. Leibham would like to have legislation drafted up that would eliminate the requirement that the state print, mail, and distribute state statutes to local governments (as defined as numbers 71-84 in state statute figure 35.84). Instead of requiring this distribution, we would be looking to allow each local government (as defined 71-84) to request one copy of the statutes available per version of printing free of charge to the municipality.

This idea came from the request of a local elected official who said that huge amounts of state statute books go unused. Its purpose would simply be to stop unwanted distribution of an expensive state publication and save the state money while still allowing access to it if a local government wishes.

Although you are the attorney, it looks to me as if this could be done by modifying 35.84 and 35.85.

I know it's a busy time of year for the LRB and there is no urgency in this bill draft, so if you could get a draft of it to our office by early-mid March it would be much appreciated.
