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## 2007 SENATE BILL 325

November 15, 2007 - Introduced by LAW REVISION COMMITTEE. Referred to Committee on Public Health, Senior Issues, Long Term Care and Privacy.

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### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Current law provides that the Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) may use federal project operations moneys, among other funds, to reimburse the costs of drugs used to treat persons with an HIV infection. This bill provides that DHFS may use federal project aids moneys rather than federal project operations moneys to reimburse these costs.
