The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 146.33 of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 **146.33 Blood donors.** Any person who is 17 years old or older may donate
- 5 blood in any voluntary and noncompensatory blood program, and any person who is
- 6 16 years old may donate blood in such a program if his or her parent or legal guardian
- 7 consents to the donation.
