## **Doug Parrott:**

Current law does not contain a clear prohibition against minors donating blood. Current law just provides that a person 17 years old or older may donate blood in a "noncompensatory" program. Do you want to provide that a person under 16 years old may not donate blood? If you elect to keep the current law authorization, as modified for 16–year–olds, do you want to maintain the qualification that it only applies if the donation is not compensated?
