2 donate blood with parental consent.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

*

Under current law, any person who is 17 years of old or older may donate blood in a voluntary and noncompensatory blood program. This bill provides that a 16-year-old may donate blood in such a program if his or her parent consents to the donation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 146.33 of the statutes is amended to read:

4 **146.33 Blood donors.** Any person who is 17 years old or older may donate
5 blood in any voluntary and noncompensatory blood program, and any person who is
6 16 years old may donate blood in such a program if his or her parent consents to the
7 donation.

Current law does not contain a clear prohibition against minors donating blood. Current law just provides that a person 17 years old or older may donate blood in a "noncompensatory" program. Do you want to provide that a person under 16 years old may not donate blood? If you elect to keep the current law authorization, as modified for 16-year-olds, do you want to maintain the qualification that it only applies if the donation is not compensated? ✓
