



2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 486

1 **AN ACT relating to:** expenditure of \$10,317.93 from moneys appropriated to the
2 Department of Natural Resources in payment of a claim against the state made
3 by the Klemme Brothers Well Drilling, Inc.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1. Claim against the state.** There is directed to be expended from
5 the appropriation under section 20.370 (4) (mq) of the statutes, as affected by the acts
6 of 2005 and 2007, \$10,317.93 in payment of a claim against the state made by
7 Klemme Brothers Well Drilling, Inc., Kewaskum, Wisconsin, as reimbursement for
8 the cost of drilling 2 wells in the town of Jackson, Washington County, that the
9 department of natural resources required to be abandoned because the wells were
10 constructed improperly, possibly as a result of incorrect information provided by the

1 department. Acceptance of this payment releases this state and its officers,
2 employees, and agents from any further liability resulting from the failure to
3 construct these wells in an appropriate manner.
