1 **AN ACT to create** 13.94 (1) (br) of the statutes; **relating to:** a fraud, waste, and
2 mismanagement hotline at the Legislative Audit Bureau.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the Legislative Audit Bureau to maintain a toll-free telephone number with voice mail to receive reports of fraud, waste, and mismanagement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 13.94 (1) (br) of the statutes is created to read:

4 13.94 (1) (br) ^{INSERT SAI-1} Maintain a toll-free telephone number with voice mail at the
5 bureau's office to receive reports of fraud, waste, and mismanagement in state
6 government. ~~The bureau~~ ^{INSERT SAI-2} shall relay these reports to the appropriate bureau
7 employee for investigation. ^{INSERT SAI-3} The bureau shall publicize the toll-free telephone
8 number on the bureau's Web site. The bureau shall maintain records that permit the



1 release of information provided by informants while protecting the identity of the
2 informant. Any records maintained by the bureau that relate to the identity of
3 informants shall be only for the confidential use of the bureau in the administration
4 of this section, unless the informant expressly agrees to release the records.
5 Appearance in court as a witness shall not be considered consent by an informant to
6 release confidential records maintained by the bureau.

November 30, 2007 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON ETHICS REFORM AND GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS.

SAI-1

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 1, line 4: after "(br)" insert "1."

SAI-2

3 2. Page 1, line 6: delete "The bureau" and substitute "Except as provided in
4 subd. 2., the bureau".

SAI-3

5 3. Page 1, line 7: after "investigation." insert "If the bureau has a bureau
6 employee investigate the report, the employee may consult with any state
7 department, board, commission, or independent agency for any purpose related to
8 the investigation."

9 4. Page 2, line 6: after that line insert:

SAI-4

10 "2. In lieu of requiring a bureau employee to conduct an investigation of a report
11 received under subd. 1., the bureau may refer a report to a state department, board,
12 commission, or independent agency for investigation. The state department, board,

1 commission, or independent agency shall conduct the investigation and deliver the
2 results of the investigation to the bureau in a timely manner.”
