

2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 591

November 29, 2007 – Introduced by LAW REVISION COMMITTEE. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1 **AN ACT** *to repeal* 343.30 (2m) of the statutes; **relating to:** suspending the
2 operating privilege of an underage person who operates a vehicle while having
3 an intoxicant in a vehicle (suggested as remedial legislation by the Department
4 of Transportation).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law allows a court to suspend the operating privilege of an underage person who operates a vehicle while there is an intoxicant in the vehicle. If the underage person has committed prior offenses, current law requires the court to suspend the operating privilege for varying periods, depending on the number of prior offenses. Current law also allows a court to suspend the operating privilege of an underage person who operates a vehicle while there is an intoxicant in the vehicle for not less than 30 days nor more than one year.

This bill eliminates the more general of these overlapping statutes, retaining the statute that requires the court to suspend the operating privilege for varying periods if there are prior offenses.
