Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This proposal repeals ss. 343.30(2m) relating to the suspension of operating privileges of a minor who operates a vehicle with an intoxicant in it.

Ss. 343.30(2m) provides penalties for an intoxicant in vehicle conviction, while ss. 346.93 does the same. Repeal of 343.30(2m) eliminates confusing and contradictory permissive statutes.
