

2007 SENATE BILL 344

December 3, 2007 – Introduced by LAW REVISION COMMITTEE. Referred to Committee on Commerce, Utilities and Rail.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 101.14 (4) (c) 1. of the statutes; **relating to:** fire detection,
2 prevention, and suppression rules governing places of employment and public
3 buildings under 60 feet in height (suggested as remedial legislation by the
4 Department of Commerce).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Commerce is required to promulgate rules requiring owners of places of employment and public buildings to install fire detection, prevention, or suppression devices to protect the health, welfare, and safety of the persons who use those places and buildings. Current law also provides that the rules governing those places and buildings that are under 60 feet in height must be based upon provisions in the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., building code. This bill provides that the rules must, instead, be based upon provisions in the International Code Council, Inc., building code.
