

Here is the language for a bill that would memorize the bridges carrying 39/90/94 over the Wisconsin River as the American Revolution Memorial Bridge

Section xx.xxx (1) Veterans of the American Revolution Memorial Bridge.

The department shall designate and mark, consistent with any standards that may be developed by the department for memorial highway designations, the bridges carrying Interstate 39/90/94 over the Wisconsin River in Columbia County between the towns of Dekorra and Caledonia as the "Veterans of the American Revolution Memorial Bridge" as a memorial to those who are buried in Wisconsin that served this nation during the Revolutionary War.

(2) Upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, including any county, city, village, or town, to cover the costs of erecting and maintaining markers specified in sub. (1), the department shall erect and maintain the markers. No state funds, other than from the receipt of contributions under this subsection, may be expended for the erection or maintenance of the markers.

(3) To the extent that such markers are consistent with standards developed by the department for memorial highway designations, the markers should be erected at the Interstate rest areas located nearest to these bridges.

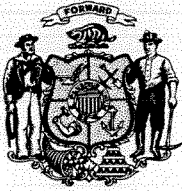
