



2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 525

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 940.208 of the statutes; **relating to:** committing battery
2 against certain employees of counties, cities, villages, and towns while the
3 employee is enforcing certain laws and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 940.208 of the statutes is created to read:

5 **940.208 Battery to certain employees of counties, cities, villages, or**
6 **towns.** Whoever intentionally causes bodily harm to an employee of a county, city,
7 village, or town under all of the following circumstances is guilty of a Class I felony:

8 **(1)** At the time of the act, the actor knows or should know that the victim is an
9 employee of a county, city, village, or town.

10 **(2)** The victim is enforcing, or conducting an inspection for the purpose of
11 enforcing, a state, county, city, village, or town zoning ordinance, building code, or

SECTION 1

1 other construction law, rule, standard, or plan at the time of the act or the act is in
2 response to any such enforcement or inspection activity.

3 **(2p)** The enforcement or inspection complies with any law, ordinance, or rule,
4 including any applicable notice requirement.

5 **(3)** There is no consent by the victim.
