# This bill permits **volunteer fire fighters** and volunteer emergency medical technicians, by agreement with their employers, to be paid quarterly.

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

Current law generally requires an employer to pay an employee his or her wages by no later than 31 days after the date on which the wages are earned. Current law, however, provides exceptions for employees engaged in logging or farm labor, employees covered by a collective bargaining agreement establishing a different payment frequency, school district and private school employees who request payment over a 12-month period for services performed during the school year, and employees who receive compensatory time off in lieu of overtime compensation. This ~~bill creates another exception for~~ volunteer fire fighters or volunteer emergency medical technicians who by agreement with their employers are paid semiannually or annually.
