Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Summary: The bill creates in the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection an agricultural education and workforce development council, of which the DNR Secretary--or the Secretary's designee--is a member. The council must meet at least annually, and, in September of each year must submit a report to the appropriate standing committees of the Legislature. The bill also specifies that the DNR may assist the council in performing its duties.

Fiscal Effect: The Department assumes that there will be a small, yet indeterminate annual fiscal effect related to time spent by the DNR Secretary or the Secretary's designee in attending council meetings and issuing annual reports, and any other time spent by DNR employees in assisting the council. The Department further assumes that any increased costs associated with these activities can be absorbed in the Department's budget.
