The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 9201. Fiscal changes; Administration.

(1) Lapse or transfer of any unencumbered moneys in appropriation accounts

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(a) Notwithstanding sections 20.001 (3) (a) to (c) and 25.40 (3) of the statutes, but subject to paragraph (b), the secretary of administration shall lapse to the general fund or transfer to the general fund from the unencumbered balances of appropriations to executive branch state agencies, other than sum sufficient appropriations and appropriations of federal revenues an amount equal to \$295,000,000 during the 2007–09 fiscal biennium and \$295,000,000 during the 2009–11 fiscal biennium. The amounts lapsed or transferred under this paragraph shall be in addition to the amounts lapsed or transferred under 2007 Wisconsin Act 20, section 9201 (1c) (a) to (c).

(b) The secretary of administration may not lapse or transfer moneys under paragraph (a) if the lapse or transfer would violate a condition imposed by the federal government on the expenditure of the moneys or if the lapse or transfer would violate the federal or state constitution.

Please modify this version [LRB 4215/1] of the lapse and transfers to the general fund to reflect the following:

- 1) The lapse should be \$350 million in each biennium, rather than the current \$295 million.
- 2) Limit the total Department of Transportation share of the lapse/transfer from 2007 Act 20 and this proposed bill to \$278 million in each biennium. (That is, from the grand total biennial lapse/transfer of \$550 million between the two bills, at most, \$278 million may come from DOT)

Insert Analysis:

2007 Wisconsin Act 20 required the secretary of administration to lapse or transfer to the general fund from appropriations to almost all executive branch state agencies, other than sum sufficient appropriations and appropriations of federal revenues, an amount equal to \$200,000,000 during the 2007–09 fiscal biennium and \$200,000,000 during the 2009–11 fiscal biennium.

The bill requires the secretary of administration to make additional lapses or transfers to the general fund from appropriations to all executive branch state agencies, other than sum sufficient appropriations and appropriations of federal revenues, in an amount equal to \$350,000,000 during the 2007-09 fiscal biennium and \$350,000,000 during the 2009-11 fiscal biennium.

The bill, however, provides that not more than a total of \$278,000,000 may be lapsed or transferred, under this act and 2007 Wisconsin Act 20, to the general fund from appropriations to the Department of Transportation during each of these fiscal biennia.
