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

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: child care payments authorization and making an
2 appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This is a preliminary draft. An analysis will be provided in a later version.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 49.155 (6m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 49.155 (6m) AUTHORIZATION FOR PAYMENT. (a) In this subsection:

5 1. "Certified provider" means a child care provider certified under s. 48.651. ✓

6 2. "Child care administrative agency" means any agency that has a contract
7 with the department to administer child care funds or any agency that has a
8 subcontract to administer child care funds with an agency that has a contract with
9 the department.

10 3. "Licensed provider" means a child care provider licensed under s. 48.65. ✓

1 (b) A child care administrative agency shall authorize payment to child care
2 providers as follows:

3 1. For a licensed provider, the child care administrative agency shall authorize
4 payment based on authorized units of service, except as follows:

5 a. The child care administrative agency may authorize payment to a licensed
6 provider based on units of service used by each child, up to the maximum number of
7 authorized units, with the reimbursement rate increased by 10 percent to account
8 for absent days, if the schedule of child care to be used is expected to vary widely.

9 b. The child care administrative agency may authorize payment to a licensed
10 provider based on units of service used by each child, up to the maximum number of
11 authorized units, if the child care administrative agency has documented 3 separate
12 occasions on which the provider significantly overreported the attendance of a child.

13 2. For a certified provider, the child care administrative agency shall authorize
14 payment for units of service used by each child, up to the maximum number of
15 authorized units, except as provided in par. (c).¹

16 (c) A child care administrative agency may authorize payment to a licensed or
17 certified provider to hold a slot for a child if the child's parent has a temporary break
18 in employment and intends to return to work and to continue to use the services of
19 the provider upon returning to work. The child care administrative agency may
20 authorize payment for no more than 6 weeks if the absence is due to a medical reason
21 and is documented by a physician or for no more than 4 weeks if the absence is due
22 to another reason. The department and child care administrative agency may not
23 consider payment for a temporary absence to be an overpayment if the parent
24 intended to, but does not actually, return to work.

1 SECTION 2. 49.175 (1) (p) of the statutes, as affected by 2007 Wisconsin Act 20,
2 is amended to read:

3 49.175 (1) (p) *Direct child care services.* For direct child care services under s.
4 49.155, ~~\$340,601,800~~ \$359,201,800 in fiscal year 2007-08 and \$355,352,000 in fiscal
5 year 2008-09.

SECTION 9254. Fiscal changes; Workforce Development.

7 (1) CHILD CARE FUNDS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes
8 for the appropriation to the department of workforce development under section
9 20.445 (3) (cm) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2007, the dollar amount is
10 increased by \$18,600,000 for fiscal year 2007-08 to increase funding for the purpose
11 for which the appropriation is made.
