On Real ID, the amendment should do two things: First, prohibit the Joint Committee on Finance from providing an appropriation supplement to DMV from its appropriation for the implementation of the Real ID act during the 2007-09 biennium; and second, transfer \$9,805,300 in 2007-08 and \$12,184,000 in 2008-09 from the transportation fund to the general fund.

I'll get back to you on how to do the additional highway spending once I clarify some things.

This bill also prohibits ICF from supplementing any DOT appropriation in fiscal year 2007–08, for purposes relating to implementation of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005, unless after the supplement there remains unexpended in the JCF appropriation, for fiscal year 2007–08, at least \$5,000,000 of the estimated expenditures in this appropriation relating to implementation of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 9148. Nonstatutory provisions; Transportation.

(1) Joint finance committee supplemental funding related to REAL ID Act IMPLEMENTATION. Notwithstanding section 13.101 (1), (3), and (5) of the statutes, the joint committee on finance may not, for purposes relating to implementation of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005, supplement in the 2007–09 fiscal biennium, from the appropriation account under section 20.865 (4) (u) of the statutes, any appropriation of the department of transportation for expenditures of the department of transportation in the 2007–09 fiscal biennium relating to implementation of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005.

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Section 9248. Fiscal changes; Transportation.

(1) Transfer to general fund. Notwithstanding section 25.40 (3) (a) of the statutes, the secretary of administration shall transfer from the transportation fund to the general fund \$9,805,300 in fiscal year 2007–08 and \$12,184,000 in fiscal year 2008–09.
