Therefore, LRB 4296/P1 should also include section 9237 (1) from the Governor's original bill. Darin and I have looked at LRB 4296/P1, and on first read, believe that it meets the Senate's intent, except for this missing section. If you could add the Governor's original provision, we would be happy as pigs in mud.

I somehow got left out of the loop on the Governor's original bill, which was OK because this provision dealt more with library aid than the USF. Evidently, I am now supposed to take the lead, as I am the PSC analyst. I assume that Darin will stay involved, as well. Thanks for the quick turn-around on yesterday's request.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
