AN ACT relating to: lapses to the general fund during the 2007–09 and 2009–11

2 fiscal biennia.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The bill requires the secretary of administration to lapse to the general fund from the unencumbered balances of general purpose revenues appropriations to executive branch state agencies, other than an appropriation to the Department of Public Instruction for general equalization aids, and most sum sufficient appropriations and appropriations of federal revenues, an amount equal to \$250,000,000 during the 2007–09 fiscal biennium and \$250,000,000 during the 2009–11 fiscal biennium. For the purpose of making the lapses, the bill permits the secretary of administration to reduce amounts in the compensation reserve dedicated to fund unbudgeted, state employee salary and fringe benefits cost increases.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 9201. Fiscal changes; Administration.

(1) Lapse of any unencumbered moneys in appropriation accounts and funds.
