4p. If the person who applies under subd. 1. will not directly return the water to the Great Lakes basin, the person shall identify the any entity that will return the water and provide evidence of support from ~~that entity~~ those entities in the form of a letter or resolution.

Amend s. 281.346 (4) (b) 4m. and 4p [pages 92-92] as follows:

4m. If a person who applies under subd. 1. will not directly withdraw the water proposed to be diverted, the person shall identify the any entity that will withdraw the water and provide evidence of support from ~~that entity~~ those entities in the form of a letter or resolution.
