



## 2007 SENATE BILL 578

1     **AN ACT relating to:** ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state  
2           of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, AFSCME Council 24,  
3           and its appropriate affiliated locals, AFL-CIO, for the 2007-09 biennium,  
4           covering employees in the technical collective bargaining unit, and authorizing  
5           an expenditure of funds.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

6           **SECTION 1. Agreement ratified.** The legislature ratifies the tentative  
7           agreement negotiated for the 2007-09 biennium between the state of Wisconsin, the  
8           office of state employment relations, and the Wisconsin State Employees Union,  
9           AFSCME Council 24, and its appropriate affiliated locals, AFL-CIO, covering  
10          employees in the technical collective bargaining unit under subchapter V of chapter  
11          111 of the statutes, as approved by the employees of the technical collective

1 bargaining unit and approved and recommended by the joint committee on  
2 employment relations, and authorizes the necessary expenditure of moneys for  
3 implementation from the appropriations made by section 20.865 (1) of the statutes,  
4 subject to section 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes. The director of the office of state  
5 employment relations shall file an official copy of the agreement, certified by the  
6 cochairpersons of the joint committee on employment relations, with the secretary  
7 of state. No formal or informal agreement between the parties that is not a part of  
8 the official copy is deemed to be approved by the legislature under this act.

9 **SECTION 2. Effective date.**

10 (1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those  
11 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement  
12 covering employees in the technical collective bargaining unit are effective on the  
13 dates provided in that agreement.
