



## 2007 SENATE BILL 584

1     **AN ACT relating to:** ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state  
2           of Wisconsin and the Milwaukee Graduate Assistants Association, AFT/WFT,  
3           Local 2169, AFL-CIO, for the 2007-09 biennium, covering employees in the  
4           program, project, and teaching assistants of the University of  
5           Wisconsin-Milwaukee collective bargaining unit, and authorizing an  
6           expenditure of funds.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

7           **SECTION 1. Agreement ratified.** The legislature ratifies the tentative  
8           agreement negotiated for the 2007-09 biennium between the state of Wisconsin, the  
9           office of state employment relations, and the Milwaukee Graduate Assistants  
10          Association, AFT/WFT, Local 2169, AFL-CIO, covering employees in the program,  
11          project, and teaching assistants of the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee collective

1 bargaining unit under subchapter V of chapter 111 of the statutes, as approved by  
2 the employees of the program, project, and teaching assistants of the University of  
3 Wisconsin–Milwaukee collective bargaining unit and approved and recommended  
4 by the joint committee on employment relations, and authorizes the necessary  
5 expenditure of moneys for implementation from the appropriations made by section  
6 20.865 (1) of the statutes, subject to section 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes. The  
7 director of the office of state employment relations shall file an official copy of the  
8 agreement, certified by the cochairpersons of the joint committee on employment  
9 relations, with the secretary of state. No formal or informal agreement between the  
10 parties that is not a part of the official copy is deemed to be approved by the  
11 legislature under this act.

**SECTION 2. Effective date.**

13 (1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those  
14 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement  
15 covering employees in the program, project, and teaching assistants of the  
16 University of Wisconsin–Milwaukee collective bargaining unit are effective on the  
17 dates provided in that agreement.
