# **2007 SENATE BILL 586**

1	$\operatorname{An}\operatorname{ACT}$ relating to: ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state
2	of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Public Defenders Association, WFT/AFT,
3	Local 4822, AFL-CIO, for the 2007–09 biennium, covering employees in the
4	public defenders collective bargaining unit, and authorizing an expenditure of
5	funds.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

# *The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

6 SECTION 1. Agreement ratified. The legislature ratifies the tentative 7 agreement negotiated for the 2007–09 biennium between the state of Wisconsin, the 8 office of state employment relations, and the Wisconsin State Public Defenders 9 Association, WFT/AFT, Local 4822, AFL–CIO, covering employees in the public 10 defenders collective bargaining unit under subchapter V of chapter 111 of the 2007 – 2008 Legislature

statutes, as approved by the employees of the public defenders collective bargaining 1 2 unit and approved and recommended by the joint committee on employment 3 relations, and authorizes the necessary expenditure of moneys for implementation 4 from the appropriations made by section 20.865 (1) of the statutes, subject to section 5 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes. The director of the office of state employment relations 6 shall file an official copy of the agreement, certified by the cochairpersons of the joint 7 committee on employment relations, with the secretary of state. No formal or 8 informal agreement between the parties that is not a part of the official copy is 9 deemed to be approved by the legislature under this act.

#### **SECTION 2. Effective date.**

(1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those
provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement
covering employees in the public defenders collective bargaining unit are effective
on the dates provided in that agreement.
