Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Chapter 88.80(1) refers to any "person" owning lands within a drainage district. The term "persons" is not defined to include State or any agency in Chapter 88 definitions and therefore WisDOT would not be subject to the requirements of this bill including assessments charged.

Chapter 88.05 (4)(a) references the following persons as to receive notice; the chair person of the county highway committee except in a county with a highway commissioner appointed under s. 83.01(1)(c), the highway commissioner; the chair person of the county land conservation committee in the county involved, the secretary of natural resources; the state drainage engineer; and, where a railroad company is involved, the person specified in sub.(6)

Reference Chapter 88.50, agricultural lands owned by the state are subject to assessment in drainage proceedings, but other lands owned by the state are not subject to such assessment. Lands acquired by the WisDOT under Chapter 84.09(1) are for transportation purposes, not agricultural purposes, and therefore not subject to this assessment.
