Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill changes the requirements that must be satisfied in order for a party to obtain title to property through adverse possession. The provisions of the bill appear to make it more difficult for a party to establish that he or she can claim title to property by adverse possession.

It is not known how many court actions may be brought to which the requirements of this bill will apply. It is expected that this bill will have a minor fiscal impact on the court system.
