### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau states that Assembly Bill 17 requires the Department of Justice (DOJ) to conduct a criminal background check on a person who applies for a license from the Department of Regulation and Licensing to provide martial arts instruction to a minor for a fee.

DOJ's Crime Information Bureau (CIB) operates, manages and disseminates information from Wisconsin's Criminal History Repository. By law, CIB is required to charge a fee for criminal history searches. Chapter 165.82 Wis. stats. sets forth the fee for the search based upon the type of request (internet, or mail or fax) and the type of requester (non-profit organization, government agency, or any other requester).

DOJ assumes that the criminal history searches required by AB 17 will be subject to the current criminal history search fee CIB charges to cover its costs. As a result DOJ, does not anticipate a fiscal impact due to the enactment of 2007 AB 17.
